Main Outcomes

The teleconference was devoted to finalization of the GeoRSS feeds. The main focus was on the GeoRSS feed on "Activations". The discussion on GeoRSS feed used for communicating details within a specific e activation (details on AOIs, satellite data or mapping products) was postponed.

The GeoRSS feed for all activations will contain the basic metadata about an activation of one EM organization. It serves to get basic information about the starting activation. It should be made available as soon as possible after the emergency mapping organization is activated to allow fast and near-real time information sharing.

During the teleconference, the feed fields and their priority were modified as bellow:
