



2009 Typhoons Non Traditional Actors






2011 Civil Unrest Libya Crisis Map



DH Network Community Interaction Diagram





Activation Facilitation Process

The Digital Humanitarians Network brings both communities together by facilitating service requests, organizing V&TCs response teams and bringing them into the same collaboration scheme.

V&TCs provide services to contribute to a given humanitarian response.

The following criteria will be considered when requesting an activation, among others:



If the request is from a professional humanitarian organization seeking remote information management support.



If the request requires services provided by the DH Network members such as geo-locaion of hospitals, 3W collection/ processing, etc.



If the requesting entity can clearly articulate their request, especially considering data complexity issues, and is prepared to manage the solution team.


A response is provided with the reasons why the request does not meet the criteria or cannot be handled by the DH Network.

At this point DH Network members might establish bilateral partnership with requesting organizations independent from the DH Network.

Some Benefits



- 1. Focal point for traditional entities
- 2. Umbrella to approach charter, private companies, etc.
- 3. Publish materials with fewer restrictions


