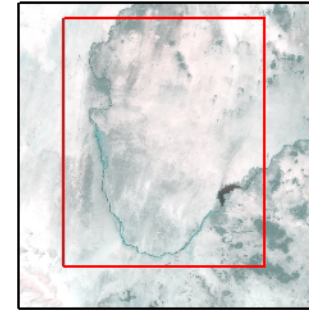


Location



Disaster Information

Since 2010, the worst drought of recent 60 years occurred in Horn of Africa. About 12 million people have been affected by the drought.

Results

Based on the NDVI, it is observed that the most part of the region is in drought condition. About 90 per cent of the vegetation cover shows less vigour than in 2010. The drought will worsen if there is no effective rainfall in the region in the following days.
