## Knowledge management

#### **Recommended Practices**

- Revising, improving existing ones (Python, SNAP, Google Earth Engine, Jupyter Notebooks)
- Incorporating new ones, particularly for hazard assessment (floods, storm surges, forest fires, and landslides)

### **Expanding the use of Satellite imagery**

- Multi-temporal interferometry for volcanic activity Early Warning
- Forest fires
- Landslides and mass movements
- To locate landslides triggered by earthquakes and intense rainfall

### Expanding the combined use of archived and upto-date imagery

Improved understanding of risk

## **Emergency support**

- Build national capacities so that mapping of impacts can be done at national level in countries affected by disasters.
- Facilitate and build capacities to access and use emergency mechanisms existing <u>outside</u> the United Nations
  - International Charter Space and Major Disasters
  - Copernicus Emergency Management Service Mapping
  - Sentinel Asia
- Facilitate the training or staff of RSOs and national disaster management agencies as project managers for the International Charter


